FRANKLIN SS:

To either of the Constables of the Town of Colrain in the County of Franklin.

GREETINGS:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said town, qualified to vote on town officers and affairs, to meet at Colrain Town Office, located at 55 Main Road at 7:00 AM – 8:00 PM in said town on Tuesday, the Thirtieth day in April next, in the year of our Lord two thousand Thirteen.

On April 30th, the polls are open from 7am – 8pm in the lower level of the Town Office building at 55 Main Road.

To cast their votes in the Annual Town Election for the following offices and Debt/Exclusion question.

1 Selectman, 1 Assessor, 2 Library Trustees, 1 Mohawk Trail Regional School District Committee Representative, 1 Constable, 1 Moderator, 1 Town Clerk. All terms are for three years unless otherwise stated.

QUESTION #1. Shall the Town of Colrain be allowed to exempt from the provisions of Proposition two and one-half, so-called, the amounts required to pay for the bond issued in order to purchase a new Fire Pumper and related equipment.

And you are directed to serve this Warrant by posting up attested copies thereof at two usual places in said town, seven days at least, before the time of holding said meeting.

Hereof, fail not, and make due return of this Warrant, with your doings thereon, to the town clerk, at the time and place of election, as aforesaid.
