1. Approve Minutes of 10/1

Barbara Griffin moved to approve the Minutes of October 1st as written, Tim Slowinski seconded. Passed unanimously.

2. Follow up on "55" Call Rd. [Map 106, Lot 6] Hearing about Andrew Conway from September 3rd and October 1st meetings.

Jasmine Ward did a reinspection on October 8th and noted that the camper still had no potable water, working septic and was running off a generator (although it wasn't running when she was there; food in the refrigerator was cold). Following up on a conversation with Mr. Conway's VA advocate, Jasmine did a drive by on the way to this meeting and confirmed that the camper is no longer there [November 6, 2024]. Mr. Conway confirmed that he is staying in Enfield, CT for the next 30 days. The health agents consider this matter resolved at this time and will be available if things change. Mr. Conway was given a letter stating that at this time the BOH cannot grant a Variance due to significant issues relating to questions of ownership, sanitation & zoning and he would need to vacate the premises within 72 hours. This order is considered fulfilled. The Board wished Mr. Conway luck moving forward and hoped the letter would assist him in getting more permanent housing.

- 3. Health Agent Updates: Randy gave the following updates.
 - He held a Serv Safe class today at the Shelburne Grange which was well attended.
 - Annual permitting renewals are starting, which is a significant undertaking due to the number of communities that they serve.
 - Area churches that hold recreational camps need to take an online course and register
 with the state. Also, questions arose about whether the kitchens need to be permitted
 depending on the level of usage. Alice will get Randy the contacts that she has for the
 local churches.
 - The FRCoG Cooperative Public Health Service program has flu vaccines available. Lisa White is available, and she will make home visits to homebound individuals.
