

**Conservation Commission Minutes**  
**Tuesday, March 11, 2025**  
**Town Office 55 Main Rd**

**Present:** David Nims, Matt Slowinski, Bill Dornbusch, Larry Richmond, Lee Denison, present. Ben Beas, absent.

**Others Present:** Alice Wozniak, Clerical Assistant

**Call to Order:** The meeting was called to order at 5:03 PM.

**Hearing:** **The Request for Determination by Alix Carey was opened.**

Alix Carey applied to repair the septic at 360 North Green River Rd but is within 200' of the Green River. The design and paperwork were reviewed by the Con Com. North Green River Rd. is a barrier to this project and separates the property from the river. The hearing was closed.

**Vote:** **Bill Dornbusch moved to find a Negative Determination, reason #3 (work occurring within the buffer zone). Matt Slowinski seconded. Passed unanimously.**

**Hearing:** **The Request for Determination by David Donovan was opened.**

The septic for 15 Main Rd failed and Peter LaBarbera, Engineer, presented a request to repair the septic system components within 75-175' of the East Branch of the North River. The plans were reviewed The hearing was closed.

**Vote:** **Lee Denison moved to find Negative Determination, reason #2. Matt Slowinski seconded. Passed unanimously.**

**Minutes:** **Bill Dornbusch moved to approve the Minutes of August 20 and November 19, 2024, as written. Lee Denison seconded. Passed unanimously.**

**New Business:** 1.) MA DOT submitted an Emergency Certification (EC) to repair a section of Route 112 near Catamount Country Store. Water was running down the embankment onto the road, making large ice patch across Route 112. Bill Dornbusch signed the EC in January, and board signed at this meeting. No further action is needed.

2.) The Board reviewed the plans for the proposed cell tower on Call Rd. It looks like the Army Corp of Engineers is involved so no action is required on the local commission.

3.) The Con Com discussed the barn demolition and lack of cleanup at 6 Greenfield Rd. Alice will compose a letter demanding the removal of the debris within 30 days. *Since this meeting, the Board of Health, in conjunction with the Building Commissioner, has taken over this case, and it's moved to Housing Court. There have been several hearings related to the case and it will be handled by the courts.*

**Adjourn:** Lee Denison moved to adjourn the meeting at 6:27 PM. Matt Slowinski seconded.
