Roll call Vote Required.

Topics to be Discussed:

- A. Review and discuss resumes and application materials submitted by candidates.
- B. Conduct preliminary interviews with applicants as deemed necessary.
- C. Deliberate and evaluate the qualifications of candidates based on the established criteria for the position.
- D. Select a list of finalists to be presented to the full Library Board of Trustees for further consideration.

¹ On March 28, 2025, Governor Healey, signed into law An Act Extending Certain COVID-19 Measures Adopted During the State of Emergency. Chapter 2 of the Acts of 2023 authorized a further extension – until June 30, 2027 – of the remote meeting provisions established by the initial March 12, 2020 Executive Order Suspending Certain Provisions of the Open Meeting Law. Section (1) of the executive order allowing public access through adequate, alternative means is independent from Section (2), which allows members of the public body to participate remotely. The public body may conduct its proceedings under the relief

provided in section (1) or (2) or both.
