

Director's Report: February 2020

Outcomes:

- Staff Picks have been very well received. As one patron commented this week, "It saves me from having to think!"

- We've collected about 50 survey responses so far. About 1/5 say, in answer to the question, "How can we improve?" that we should expand service hours. Most say that they would recommend the library to others.
