To either of the Constables of the Town of Colrain in the County of Franklin.

GREETINGS:


In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said town, qualified to vote on town affairs, **to meet at The Colrain Town Office, located at 55 Main Road at 7:00 PM in said town on Monday the 27th day of February in the year of our Lord two thousand seventeen, there and then to act on the following article:**

ARTICLE #1. To see if the Town will vote to appropriate the sum of Four Hundred and Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$480,000) to fund a capital project described as follows: The removal of a portion of the existing Highway Garage Building to be replaced with a 2,500SF building addition housing a manual vehicle washing bay, administrative offices and a storage mezzanine and to undertake repairs and upgrades to the remaining portions of the existing highway garage and that to meet this appropriation to authorize the Board of Selectmen to transfer the sum of Four Hundred and Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$420,000) from the Stabilization Fund and Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000) from free cash to fund such project or pass any vote or votes in relation thereto.

And you are directed to serve this Warrant by posting up attested copies thereof at two usual places in said town, seven days at least, before the time of holding said meeting.

Hereof, fail not, and make due return of this Warrant, with your doings thereon, to the town clerk, at the time and place of meeting, as aforesaid.


