

Structural Change Request Form

Instructions

Pursuant to 935 CMR 500.104(1)(c) and 501.104(1)(c), a licensee must submit a structural review request before the building or renovation of a Marijuana Establishment (ME) and/or Medical Marijuana Treatment Center (MTC), which includes any modification, remodel, expansion or reduction, or any other physical, non-cosmetic alteration of the building. The licensee **shall not** begin any building or renovations until the structural review request is approved by the Cannabis Control Commission (Commission). Failure to obtain Commission approval may result in enforcement action, including suspension, revocation, or voiding of the license.

For a licensee to receive approval to begin building or renovating an ME and/or MTC, this form must be completed and signed by an individual with authority or control over the management and operations of the ME and/or MTC (Licensee's Representative). Once completed, this form and all additional information or documentation must be combined into a single PDF document and emailed to archreview@cccmass.com.

In addition to submitting this form, the licensee must submit the appropriate fee using the fee remittance section below. Pursuant to 935 CMR 500.005(1)(e) and 501.005(3), the fee for this request is \$1,000 per license affected. Please follow the instructions for remitting payment contained on the remittance form. Please note that your request will not be processed until the required fee is received.

Required Information and Documentation

1. Please provide a brief description of the proposed structural alterations:

Our existing outdoor farm is seeking to do two things:

1. Expand the immediately adjacent footprint of our field to allow for better spacing and growing conditions of the plants. We do not plan to expand or reduce our overall licensed canopy size.

2. We are seeking to enclose a previously unused part of the farm for additional outdoor cultivation and propagation. This enclosure will have no artificial light and will house two greenhouses that are each 96' x 21' high wall greenhouses. We do not plan to expand or reduce our overall licensed canopy size through this use.



2. Please provide the ME/MTC's plan to remain compliant with all state laws and local ordinances, specifically, building, fire, plumbing, electrical, and zoning codes that will be affected during building or renovations:

Plan to Remain Compliant:

1. MA Craft Cultivation will continue to only use the licensed space for its day to day cannabis operations until all approvals are received.
2. MA Craft Cultivation has engaged with the Colrain Building Department/Inspector to secure all local permits and approvals required prior to completing the work. We have been told this work does not require additional permits to be completed.
3. Apply and receive approval for the renovations from the CCC.
4. Complete renovations, secure CCC approval to use the additional spaces, and commence operations for the additional space.



3. Please provide the ME/MTC's plan to remain compliant with the energy efficiency and conservation regulations codified in 935 CMR 500.105, 935 CMR 500.103, 935 CMR 500.105(15), and 935 CMR 500.120(11), and/or corresponding medical regulations, as applicable:

There are no changes regarding energy efficiency that are a part of this change. Accordingly, we plan to remain compliant with all energy efficiency and conservation regulations. Every aspect of our current establishment is compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act Accessibility Guidelines and this change will also conform to those guidelines. As an outdoor farm, we believe we are among the most energy efficient cultivation operations in operation in Massachusetts.

- e. Pursuant to 935 CMR 500.005(1)(e) and 501.005(3), the licensee has submitted the appropriate fee associated with this request for a structural change.

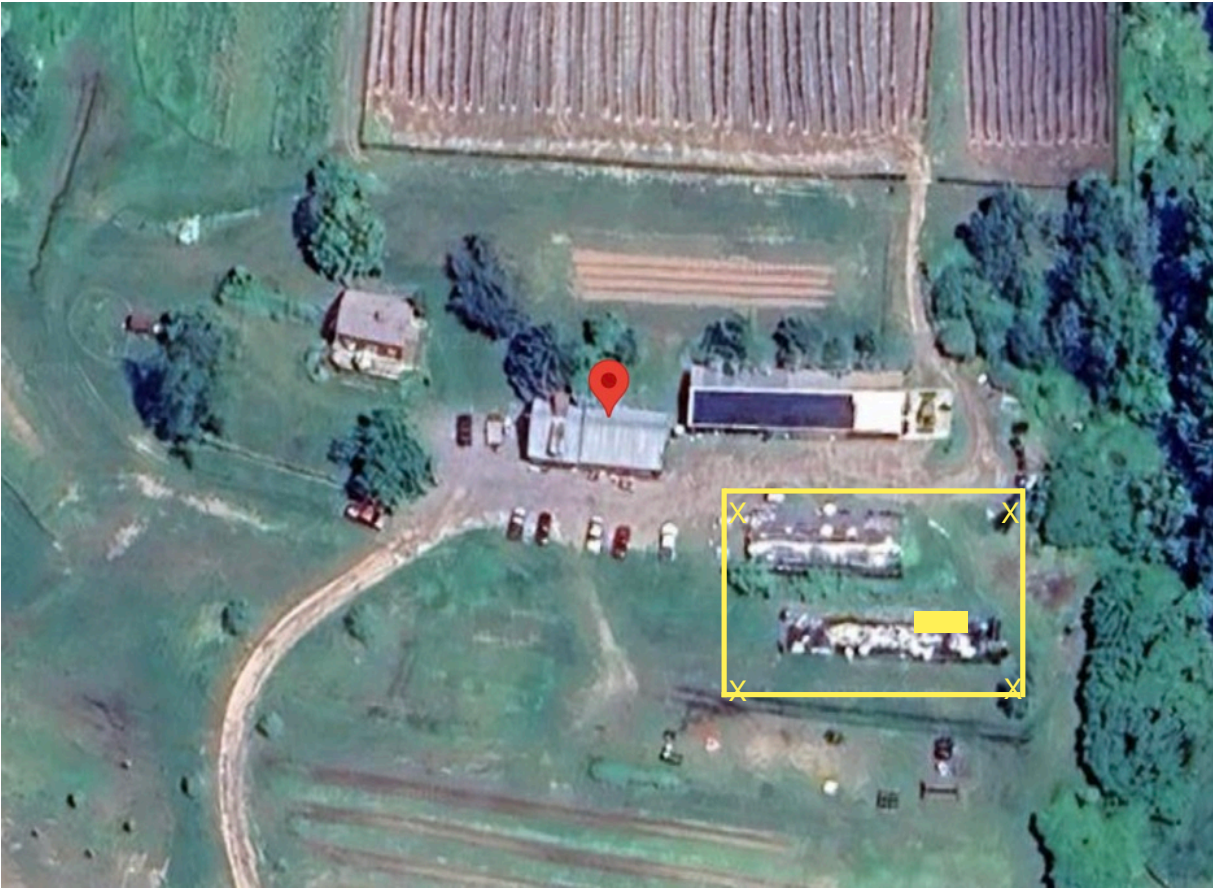
Part One: Expanding The Field

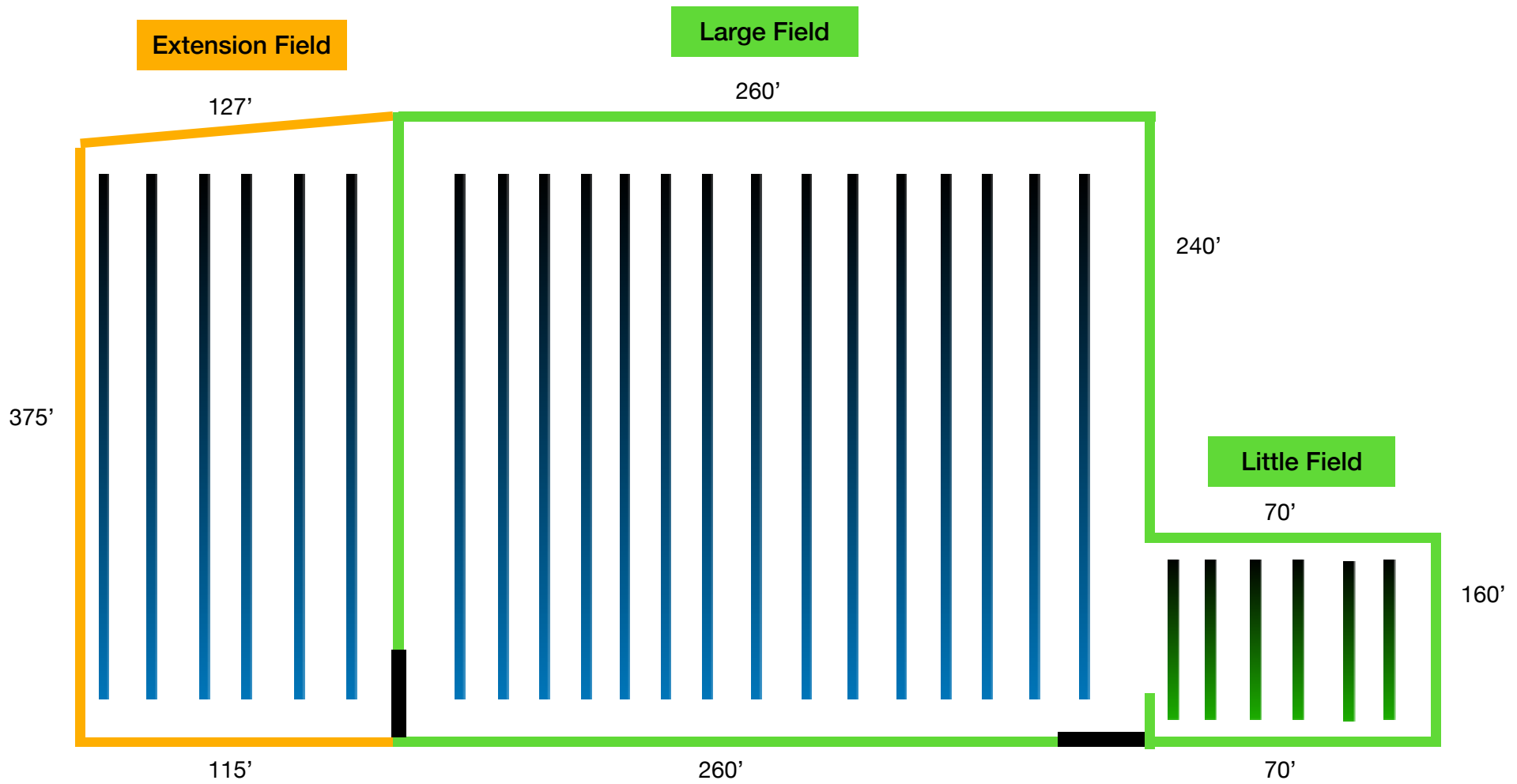
This diagram below shows the field plan/floor plan for the outdoor area we are proposing expansion. Existing gate is noted as well as the proposed new gate. All additional cameras are marked with an X.



Part 2: Enclosing additional space for growing and propagation

This diagram below shows the field/floor plan for the outdoor grow area we are proposing to build a fence around and use as part of our cultivation operation. The picture below is a real-life picture of the area that is going to be enclosed and used. These are open-air structures that will be covered with transparent liners as to remain fully outdoor cultivation facilities. The yellow block is the proposed gate with a lock and the X's are proposed camera locations.

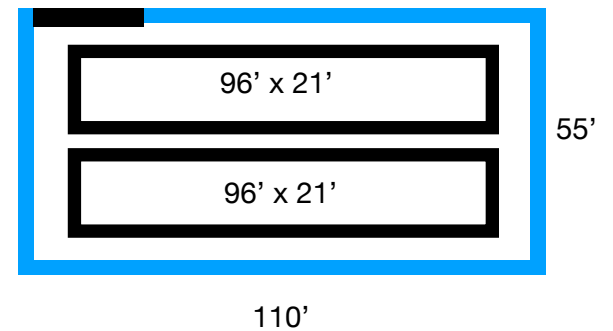
