# Anyone over the age of five can receive a COVID-19 vaccine.

#### 1<sup>st</sup> booster shots are available for:

• Anyone over age 12, five months after their last Pfizer or Moderna dose, or two months after their last Johnson and Johnson dose

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> booster shots are available for:

- Those over age 50 who received their 1st booster more than 4 months ago
- Those with certain medical conditions

All three vaccine types (Pfizer, Moderna, Johnson & Johnson) are available at each clinic.
